Project news: Tampa Airport Interchanges (State Road 60)

Detours on State Road 60 near TPA

TAMPA -- Eastbound or westbound State Road 60/Memorial Highway may be closed near the Spruce Street/ Tampa International Airport (TPA) interchange as needed Friday night (January 29) and Sunday through Friday (January 31 - February 5) nights. Eastbound closures will happen between 10:30 p.m. and 4:30 a.m.; westbound closures will occur between 11:30 p.m. and 4:30 a.m. Watch closely for lighted message signs alerting of the closures and to guide you to the detours.

* DETOUR for EASTBOUND SR 60 CLOSURE: Traffic will be directed off at the Spruce Street/TPA exit, continue east on Spruce St. to Westshore Blvd., then south on Westshore Blvd. to Cypress St., northbound I-275, or Kennedy Blvd. To access southbound I-275, continue south on Westshore Blvd., then turn right onto Kennedy Blvd., continue west and use the entrance ramp on the west side of Westshore Plaza.

* DETOUR for WESTBOUND SR 60 CLOSURE: Traffic will be directed off at the Spruce Street exit, then u-turn at O’Brien Street and use the westbound Spruce entrance ramp to westbound SR 60.

Detours for eastbound Courtney Campbell to northbound Memorial/Veterans early mornings

TAMPA -- Eastbound State Road 60 traffic on the Courtney Campbell Parkway going north toward the Veterans Expressway and other roads to the north may be detoured from 12 a.m. to 4 a.m. Saturday through Saturday (January 30 - February 6) mornings as crews do bridge work over the road. DETOUR: Drivers will be directed on eastbound SR 60/Memorial Highway to the Spruce Street exit, where they will then make a u-turn at the traffic signal at O’Brien Street, and then enter westbound State Road 60/northbound Memorial Highway to the Veterans and other connecting roadways.

SR 60 exits to airport may be closed at night

TAMPA -- The eastbound and westbound State Road 60/ Memorial Highway exits to George Bean Parkway (roadway into Tampa International Airport) may be closed between 10:30 p.m. and 4:30 a.m. Friday night (January 29) and Sunday through Friday (January 31 - February 5) nights. DETOUR: Traffic will be directed onto eastbound Spruce Street. Get into the left lane, u-

turn at the traffic signal at O'Brien Street, and use the westbound Spruce Street ramp into the airport.

Lane closures and detours for TPA exit road at night

TAMPA -- There will be lane closures on southbound George Bean Parkway (outbound road from Tampa International Airport) between 8:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Friday night (January 29) and Sunday through Friday (January 31 - February 5) nights. There may also be total ramp closures from 12:30 a.m. to 4:30 a.m. Saturday through Saturday (January 30 - February 6). Traffic will be routed to eastbound Spruce Street, then u-turn at the O'Brien Street intersection and enter westbound State Road 60 / northbound Memorial Highway. For drivers going to eastbound State Road 60 or I-275, they will continue east on Spruce Street, then go south on Westshore Boulevard to northbound I-275 or Kennedy Boulevard (eastbound SR 60). To access southbound I-275, turn right on Kennedy Boulevard, continue west and use the entrance ramp by turning left across from the west side of Westshore Plaza.

Night lane closures between Kennedy Boulevard and Veterans Expressway

TAMPA -- One to two lanes may be closed in either direction on any of the travel lanes of State Road 60 / Memorial Highway from Kennedy Boulevard (south of I-275) to the Veterans Expressway from 8:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. Friday night (January 29) and Sunday through Friday (January 31 - February 5) nights.

Westbound Spruce Street may be closed early mornings near TPA

TAMPA -- Westbound Spruce Street (entrance to westbound SR 60/northbound Veterans/Eisenhower) may be closed just east of State Road 60 between 12 a.m. and 4 a.m. Saturday through Saturday (January 30 - February 6) mornings. DETOUR to westbound SR 60/northbound Memorial Highway: Go south on Westshore Boulevard, then west on Kennedy Boulevard (SR 60) which turns into Memorial Highway at I-275. Follow signs towards Independence Parkway, and then use George St. or Independence to go to Memorial.

Flagging operations on eastbound SR 60 access roads at Bayport Drive

TAMPA -- Traffic may be controlled by flaggers on the eastbound State Road 60 access roads to and from Bayport Drive (Grand Hyatt) any time Friday through Saturday (January 29 - February 6). Drivers should be alert to temporary new ramp alignments, including a stop before entering eastbound S.R. 60.

Lane closures on Cypress Street

TAMPA -- One lane may be closed in each direction of Cypress Street between O'Brien Street and Reo Street from 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Friday through Saturday (January 29 - February 6).

One-lane traffic on N. Frontage Road

TAMPA -- One lane may be closed on North Frontage Road between Cypress Street and Laurel Street from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Friday through Saturday (January 29 - February 6). Flaggers will direct traffic.

maintenance: Interstate 275 on the Sunshine Skyway Bridge

Thursday night lane closures on the Sunshine Skyway Bridge

ST. PETERSBURG -- The right lane of I-275 will be closed in various locations in both directions of the lower levels of the Sunshine Skyway Bridge between 7:30 p.m. Thursday (February 4) and 6 a.m. Friday (February 5). Crews will be doing routine bridge inspections.

maintenance: Interstate 275

Night lane closures on the northbound Howard Frankland Bridge

ST. PETERSBURG/TAMPA -- Two of four lanes will be closed for maintenance work on northbound I-275 on the Howard Frankland Bridge about 2.3 miles west of State Road 60 (Exits 39 A/B) between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. Monday through Thursday (February 1 - 4) nights.

Project news: Northbound I-275 Connector to CR 296 / SR 686

Day and night lane closures on Roosevelt Boulevard at I-275

ST. PETERSBURG -- One to two lanes may be closed in each direction of Roosevelt Boulevard (State Road 686) from I-275 to 28th Street North from 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Friday through Saturday (January 29 - February 6). Expect closures in the same area from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Friday and Saturday (January 29 and 30 and February 5 and 6) nights.

Southbound I-275 exit to Roosevelt / CR 296 to be closed January 29 and 30 mornings

ST. PETERSBURG -- Either the southbound I-275 Exit 30 to Roosevelt Boulevard (State Road 686) or County Road 296 (118th Avenue) may be closed from 12:01 a.m. to 5:30 a.m. Friday and Saturday (January 29 and 30) mornings. The exit to *Roosevelt* will be closed Friday morning; the exit to *CR 296* will be closed Saturday morning.

DETOURS: Use Exit 31 and take Ulmerton Road (State Road 688) west to Roosevelt Boulevard. If going to County Road 296, go east on Roosevelt, then turn right on 28th Street North and continue to County Road 296 / 118th Avenue.

I-275 traffic to be detoured at Roosevelt Blvd. Sat./Sun. mornings / lane closures at night

ST. PETERSBURG -- Traffic will be detoured off either northbound or southbound I-275 at Exit 30 between 12 a.m. and 5:30 a.m. Friday and Saturday (January 29 and 30) mornings. *Northbound* will be detoured Friday morning (Thursday night into Friday morning) and *southbound* will be detoured Saturday morning (Friday night into Saturday morning).

Prior to the detours, traffic will be reduced to one lane approaching Exit 30 (Roosevelt Boulevard/SR 686), beginning at 8 p.m. Then, after midnight, traffic will be directed off at the exit ramp, across Roosevelt Boulevard, and back onto the interstate using the entrance ramp.

Lane closures on CR 296

ST. PETERSBURG -- One lane will be closed in each direction of County Road 296 (118th Avenue) from 28th Street to 40th Street from 7:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. Saturday through Friday (January 30 - February 5) nights.

Project news: I-75/I-275 Exit Ramps to State Road 56

Night lane closures on northbound I-75 approaching SR 56

NEW TAMPA -- One lane will be closed on northbound I-75 from south of Interstate 275 to State Road 56 (Exit 275) from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (January 31 - February 4) nights.

Night lane closures on I-275 approaching and onto I-75

NEW TAMPA -- One of two lanes will be closed on northbound I-275 approaching and onto northbound I-75 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (January 31 - February 4) nights.

Thursday night ramp closure from northbound I-75 to SR 56

NEW TAMPA -- The northbound I-75 exit ramp to State Road 56 (Exit 275) will be closed after 11:30 p.m. Thursday (February 4) night and finish by 5 a.m. Friday (February 5). DETOUR: Continue to the next exit (279), turn right and go east to Bruce B. Downs Boulevard, then turn right and go south to S.R. 56.

Project news: Interstate 75 Interchange at County Road 54

Night lane closures on I-75 near CR 54

WESLEY CHAPEL -- One lane will be closed on northbound and southbound I-75 from north of the rest area to north of County Road 54 (Exit 279) between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (January 31 - February 4) nights.

CR 54 to be closed under I-75 at night

WESLEY CHAPEL -- County Road 54 will be closed under I-75 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (January 31 - February 4) nights. All ramps will be open, but no traffic will be able to cross under I-75. DETOUR: Local traffic will be detoured using State Road 54, County Road 54, Bruce B. Downs Boulevard, and the I-75 interchange at State Road 56.
